All events are at the Quality Inn of Somerset. The Inn is located at the entrance to the PA Turnpike. Exit 110.

Reservations must be made by March 22nd to get the group rate. If in doubt, reserve. Pet friendly hotel – one time charge of \$25.

CUISINE:

Inn restaurant open only for breakfast. Continental breakfast is complimentary. Many other dining choices available nearby and on North Center St. Fast foods also in area. The Eat N' Park restaurant offers a 10% discount when you show your Quality Inn room entry card. Kings Restaurant offers 20% with motel entry card.
